

The CRAB Mobility Team is happy to announce the release of Mobility 3.2.0.

Mobility 3.2.0 includes several new inventories, reports, analysis tools, and data management features. As always, the enhancements to Mobility are driven by county feedback gathered through support calls, emails, training sessions, and our online feedback report.

The major changes included in this release of Mobility are:

1. 5 new inventories
 - a. Cattle Guards: Some counties manage hundreds of cattle guards and have requested that they be included in Mobility.
 - b. Curb Ramps: This inventory was created to assist counties with meeting ADA requirements.
 - c. Railroad Crossings: If you plan to use this inventory your Mobility administrator needs to setup the lookup values for Railroad Name and Railroad Sight Distance Obstruction. This can be done from Admin->Manage Lookups->Lookup Tables.
 - d. Short Span Bridges: This inventory has been requested as an alternative to keeping short span bridge data in WSDOT BridgeWorks. Short Span Bridges has been pre-populated with records from the Mobility Bridge inventory that have a structure length of less than 24 feet.
 - e. Traffic Signals: This robust inventory will allow counties to record and track their traffic signals.

Note: If you plan to use these new inventories and track maintenance your Mobility administrator needs to setup new maintenance activity codes from Admin->Manage Lookups->Maintenance Activity Numbers.

2. In addition to the new inventories, we've included a new feature called Improvement Change Tracking. This is an optional feature and will assist with tracking changes to the road log cross section data.
3. Miscellaneous changes include:
 - a. A new menu level for Administrators to manage Lookup Tables (Admin/Manage Lookups.....)
 - b. Alphabetization of the Feature List and Road List Filter/Inventories allows for easier navigation.
 - c. Syntax highlighting in custom reports to make writing queries easier to construct and read.
 - d. Storm Systems clone feature.
 - e. New reports:

Road Miles By Surface Type By FFC - Canned

Reference Points with BMP and EMP - Canned
Cattle Guards – Canned and Custom
